25A FLAIL MOWER:

- Quiet running — perfect for use around hospitals, businesses, schools, and nursing homes.
- Big 6 ½-foot cutting width.
- Adjustable cutting height — ½ to 5 inches, depending on tractor and tire size.
- Three-bank, counterbalanced rotor revolves at 1,850 rpm, with cutting-tip speed of more than 100 mph.
- Replaceable, heat-treated steel knives — strategically arranged for uniform distribution of clippings across full cutting width.
- Pivoting blades minimize damage when an obstruction is hit.
- Compatible with 3520, 3720, 4120, 4320, 4520, 4720, 5105, 5205, 5220, 5320 and 5420 tractors.

360, 370, AND 390 FLAIL MOWERS:

- For long-lasting performance in the toughest mowing environments, look to the 300 Series Flail Mowers. John Deere flail mowers provide smooth, clean cutting of grass and weeds — even tough brush.
- Cutting widths range from 4-feet 10-inches to 7-feet 6-inches. And the largest model also comes in an offset design for cutting up close to tree trunks in orchards.
- Heat-treated, side-slicer knives rip into grass, weeds, and light brush at 95 mph. Heavy-duty gearcases have a continuous 45 horsepower rating to withstand lots of punishment.
- On the outside, tough 3/16-inch-thick hoods resist wear and dents caused by fast flowing debris.

- The 390 26-inch offset model lets you get under limbs and branches to cut grass and weeds, right up to the tree trunk.
- Reliable, heavy-duty HC-section belts drive the rotor on the 360 and 370. A heavier, two-section, 5VX, notched belt drives the 390's rotor.
- Skid plates absorb most of the shock from contact with the ground, protecting the side of the mower. The 390 also features adjustable skid shoes for extra support.
- Compatible with 5105, 5205, 5220, 5320 and 5420 tractors.

- 4120-4720 can use 370.
