### Information





SA221 has no range shift lever since it is a single range shift. The transmission allows the operator the ability to freewheel the tractor in the event it need to be moved while the engine is not running.

#### **WARNING** - When towing the tractor:

- travel slower than 10 mph (16 km/h)
- always have another person sit on the tractor to allow independent operation of the steering and brakes when required.

#### **Control Lever Setting:**

1. Push down Power Take Off (PTO) switch (A) to OFF position.
2. Disengage the parking brake (B).
3. Disengage the 4-wheel drive (C).
4. Access to the rear left side of the tractor after setting the control levers.



#### **Moving the range shift lever into Neutral:**

5. Insert the screw driver (B) into the hole of the shaft at the joint of Mid-/Rear Power Take Off (PTO) select lever (A) under the left fender.
6. Pull the screw driver backward (a) until the shaft can rotate clockwise (backward).
7. Make sure that the tractor can be moved by hand and take the screw driver out of the hole.

#### **CAUTION**

After pushing or towing the tractor, make sure to return the shaft to the original position pushing the screw driver forward (b) until the shaft can rotate counterclockwise (forward).

Otherwise the tractor will not move when the HST is pressed.
